

## **What On Earth Am I Here For? Take Home #5**

**Read Ephesians 2:10 five times before you work through the questions below.**

*The greatest gift God gives us is salvation in Jesus Christ. When we accept God's gift, we have eternal life. But God doesn't expect us to sit back and cruise through the rest of life. God expects salvation to be worked out in us for the rest of our days. The longer we live as followers of Jesus, the more our lives should look like his because of God's work in us and through us.*

*Sometimes this process of becoming more and more like Jesus in every area of our lives can be pretty challenging—and even painful. It doesn't take long before we're faced with areas in need of improvement.*

- 1. In the prayer we prayed we asked God to “do whatever it takes” to make you into the image of Jesus, what would God “chisel” first in your life?**
- 2. What “tools” might God use to chisel away areas of your life that need to be reshaped or re- moved altogether?**
- 3. What do you think would be the most painful or uncomfortable thing about the chiseling process?**
- 4. Has there been a time when you felt like God was “chiseling” on your life? If so, describe it on the back. If not, why do you think it has never happened to this point in your life?**
